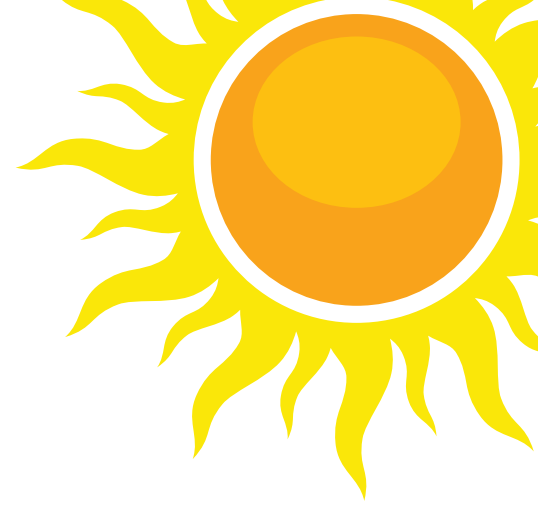

Hearing Loss is one of the **most common** conditions affecting newborns.



Research has shown that one-third of children with hearing loss have failed at least one grade during their school years and nearly 50% need special resource assistance.
