- Tinnitus is a perceived sound of ringing, hissing, buzzing, whistling or similar noise in the ear with no external source.
- Tinnitus is considered

 a symptom rather than
 a condition and is often

 associated with other diseases.
- 90% of all individuals with tinnitus have some degree of hearing loss.¹
